DISD Dress Code Policy (*DISD FNCA-Local*)

GIRLS

Top:

- Polo-style long- or short-sleeve shirts:
 - 6th: White
 - 7th: Gray
 - 8th: Navy Blue
- Shirt logos: Manufacture trademarks, if any, must be one inch or less. District school logos are permitted and not limited in size.
***Long logo available not mandatory.**

Bottom:

- Pants:
 - Must be navy, black, or khaki *with* pockets.
 - **No denim, leggings, or jeggings.**
- Shorts:
 - Must be navy, black, or khaki.
 - Must extend to within two inches of the top of the knee.
**If shorts are rolled up, hemmed up, taken up and do not extend within two inches above the knee, then the student will not be allowed to wear the shorts for the entire school year.*
- Skirts: **(NEW!)**
 - J.L. Long approved plaid **only**. (Sold at Parker School Uniforms in Casa Linda.)
 - Must extend to within two inches of the top of the knee.
**If skirts are rolled up, hemmed up, taken up and do not extend within two inches above the knee, then the student will not be allowed to wear the skirt for the entire school year.*
- Tights and Leggings:
 - All tights and leggings must be worn under approved skirt.
 - They must be solid black only.
 - No denim leggings.
- Footwear:
 - Athletic shoes, loafers, dress shoes, or other closed-toed/closed-heel shoes. Mules described as closed-toed and open-heel are appropriate.



BOYS

Top:

- Polo-style long- or short-sleeve shirts:
 - 6th: White
 - 7th: Gray
 - 8th: Navy Blue
- Shirt logos: Manufacture trademarks, if any, must be one inch or less. District school logos are permitted and not limited in size. ***Long logo available not mandatory.**

Bottom:

- Pants:
 - Must be navy, black, or khaki *with* pockets.
 - **No denim, leggings, or jeggings.**
- Shorts:
 - Must be navy, black, or khaki.
 - Must extend no more than two inches to the top of the knee.
 - **If shorts are rolled up, hemmed up, taken up and do not extend within two inches above the knee, then the student will not be allowed to wear the shorts for the entire school year.*
- Footwear:
 - Athletic shoes, loafers, dress shoes, or other closed-toed/closed-heel shoes. Mules described as closed-toed and open-heel are appropriate.

OUTERWEAR

- **Sweaters, Hoodies, Cardigans, and Sweatshirts:** must be solid colors of gray, black, navy, or white and shirt collars **MUST** be visible
- **Jackets/Coats:** All jackets must be appropriately sized. Jackets containing offensive slogans, symbols, and other suggestive or controversial designs are not allowed. All District-issued school jackets are permitted.
***Jackets that are not solid school approved colors must be removed during the school day.**
Shirts cannot be worn as outerwear.
